ANNOUNCEMENTS

SAINTS PETER AND PAUL:

Saints Peter and Paul are the principal pillars of the Church founded by Christ.

Peter was chosen by Christ to be his first Vicar on Earth; he was endowed with powers of the keys of the Kingdom of the Heaven and charged with the role of Shepherd of Christ flock. In Saint Peter and his successors, we have a visible sign of unity and communion in Faith and Charity. Divine grace led Peter to profess Christ's divinity. Saint Peter suffered martyrdom under Nero, in about the year 64 AD. He was buried at the hill of the Vatican; recent excavations have revealed his tomb on the very site of the Basilica of Saint Peter.

Saint Paul was chosen to form part of the Apostolic College by Christ himself on the road to Damascus. Selected to bring Christ's name to all people, he is the greatest missionary of all times, the advocate of pagans, the Apostle of the Gentiles. Saint Paul was beheaded in the Tré Fontane along the Via Ostiense and buried nearby, on the site where the Basilica, bearing his name, now stand.

SANTOS PEDRO Y PABLO:

Los santos Pedro y Pablo son los pilares principales de la Iglesia fundada por Cristo.

Pedro fue elegido por Cristo para ser su primer Vicario en la Tierra; fue dotado de tener las llaves del Reino de los Cielos y encargado de la función de Pastor del rebaño de Cristo. En san Pedro y en sus sucesores tenemos un signo visible de unidad y comunión en la fe y en la caridad. La gracia divina llevó a Pedro a profesar la divinidad de Cristo. San Pedro sufrió el martirio bajo Nerón, alrededor del año 64 D.C. Su cuerpo fue enterrado en la colina del Vaticano; recientes excavaciones han revelado su tumba en el mismo sitio de la Basílica de San Pedro. Pablo fue elegido para formar parte del Colegio Apostólico por Cristo mismo en el camino a Damasco. Seleccionado para llevar el nombre de Cristo a todas las personas, es el misionero más grande de todos los tiempos, el defensor de los paganos, el Apóstol de los gentiles. San Pablo fue decapitado en el Tré Fontane a lo largo de la Via Ostiense y enterrado cerca, en el sitio donde ahora se encuentra la Basílica que lleva su nombre.

 of the world, the flesh and the devil, and
 may be made worthy to appear before the
 chief and eternal Shepherd of souls, Jesus
 Christ, Who with the Father and the Holy
 Ghost liveth and reigneth for endless ages,
 to enjoy His presence and love Him forever.

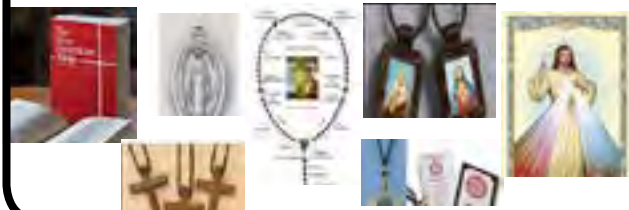
