All Parishioners 18 years and older are urged to register at the Church Office. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which people become members of the Roman Catholic Church. Sessions are held on Tuesday evenings at 6:00 pm. ### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Please contact the priest 9-12 months in advance for pre-wedding counseling. A Wedding Handbook is available in the Parish Office which provides information on preparing for a Catholic marriage.

### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

## BLACK HISTORY MONTH REMEMBERING THE PAST PARISHIONERS

### JUDGE ALFONSO A. CHRISTIAN I (August 2, 1916 - July 23, 2005)

Judge Alphonso A. Christian I was born in Frederiksted, St. Croix, at No.40 Prince street to Peter and Wilhelmina Christian, on August 2, 1916. He was the tenth child in a family of fifteen children. From his birth, the church was not only his spiritual advisor and support, but often a decision maker to important matters. His very name, Alphonso, was because he born on the feast of Saint Alphonsus Liguori. The Belgian priest who baptized him gave him the name Alphonsus. This is precisely how it appears on his baptismal record where the Roman Catholic Church was most influential. His schooling began in St. Patrick's Parochial School at age six (6). He graduated in June 1933, as the Valedictorian. It seems that his large Catholic family in St. Croix was just the perfect background and foundation for the family life he would be heir to in St. Thomas. He was placed with the Hughes sisters to board. These were two lovely spinsters who lived near Sts. Peter and Paul Church later to become a Cathedral. These ladies were very kind to him. He stated that unless Father Edward Baumann, the Superior at Sts. Peter and Paul at the time (1933-1939), had not interceded on his behalf, these ladies would never have opened their beautiful home and extended their kindness and hospitality to him. Judge Christian served as legal counsel to the Church for almost 50 years and, to the bishops, most notably Bishop Harper, as they formed the first Roman Catholic Diocese. He was the first chairman of the Finance Committee of the Diocese and also the chairman of the Executive Development Committee of Sts. Peter and Paul Cathedral for the creation of an Endowment Fund of \$2,300,000.00 in three years. He received the Papal Award, the Order of St. Gregory the Great, from Pope John Paul II in 2002. Judge Christian died on July 23, 2005. In his will, he gave a very sizeable contribution to Sts. Peter and Paul Cathedral.

### ARTURO R. WATLINGTON SR. (January 21, 1911 - September 13, 1998)

Arturo R. Watlington was born on January 21, 1911 to Herminia Johnson and Joseph Watlington in the Savan area of St. Thomas. He attended St. Ann's Catholic School, now known as Sts. Peter and Paul School. After graduation he worked for the Marines and then went on to teach at the Mafolie Church School. Throughout his life, he was a dedicated parishioner at St. Peter and Paul Church where he served as an altar boy and sacristan. In the early forties, he founded the first Catholic Boy Scout troop and encouraged a host of young people to attend mass and Sunday School. Outside of the church, Arturo had a long, illustrious postal career, where he rose through the ranks from a postal clerk to the highest-ranking position of Postmaster. To honor his many years of dedicated service, the Frenchtown - Veterans Drive Annex Post Office was named in his honor. Though the Postal Service was a major part of his life, service to the church was ever present. Arturo attended mass daily and continued his work as a sacristan and as an usher throughout his adult life. He was appointed as Redemptorist Oblate in 1982 and shortly thereafter was ordained a Deacon in 1984. Along with his wife of 58 years, Elesa B. Watlington, Arturo visited the sick and shut in and distributed communion weekly. Together, Arturo and Elesa contributed monetarily and physically whenever and wherever they could in service to their faith. Today, his family continues to be dedicated parishioners of Sts. Peter and Paul Cathedral. Humble, generous, religious and affectionate are just a few words that could have been used to describe Arturo, affectionately known as "Pepe" to his seven children, family and friends. May his impact and memory continue to live on within the Church and beyond.
